NCWGA is sponsoring a \$500.00 Scholarship for 2011. Any graduating senior or a student currently enrolled in an accredited or chartered school is eligible. You must be a member in good standing, Junior or Regular to qualify. In addition, you must have proof of acceptance or enrollment in said school, have and maintained a grade point average of 2.0 and have raised natural colored sheep. Along with a completed application, three letters of recommendation from qualified people such as teachers, counselors, or community leaders shall be included.

This scholarship is based on merit, not financial need. Remember to give a complete outline of yourself. In addition to academics, include community and other organization involvement. Pictures, newspaper articles, etc. are acceptable documents.

Deadline is July 15, 2011

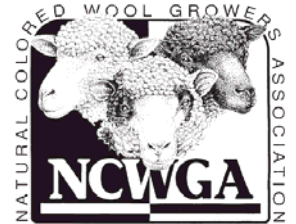

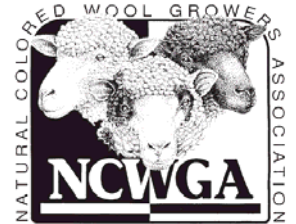
